TIMELINES

Parents and teachers may refer students for testing within the following timelines.

OCTOBER 1ST DEADLINE FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 1 - 12

DECEMBER 1ST DEADLINE FOR STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN KINDERGARTEN & 2ND GRADERS ALL of kindergarten will be screened in the Fall, however if you would like to refer them you may do so before December 1st.

ALL 2nd graders will participate in a grade level administration of a cognitive abilities test during the fall semester so there is no need to refer them for testing. HOW TO MAKE A REFERRAL

If you are interested in having your child tested this year, please email the Advanced Academics Specialist, Jean Neyland, at jneyland@ccisd.net . Please include your child's: Full Name, Homeroom Teacher, & Grade. Your child will not be able to be tested until all forms are returned.

School Store!

The NPE School Store is open daily from 7:45 – 8:10 and is stocked with a variety of school supplies and specialty items.

Students are invited to stop by on their way to class. We ask that students leave their backpacks in the hallway and enter the store with only their money. There is a limit of 3 shoppers allowed inside the store at a time.

To make shopping easy for all students, items are arranged on shelves according to price. Prices begin at 25¢ and go up in quarter increments stopping at \$1.75. The items available for purchase change weekly as items sell out and new merchandise arrives. We are trying out something new this year - Student PTA members will have the opportunity to help select items to sell in our school store! If your child is a PTA member, they will be receiving an invitation in the next few weeks

Here is a sampling of items available for purchase:

25¢ - assorted pencils, donut scented erasers, pencil bags

50¢ - dry erase markers, puzzle erasers, Dog Man erasers, laptop stickers, scented bookmarks, folders, pencil grips

75¢ - Dog Man 3D erasers, bendy pencils, scented highlighters, pop-a-point pencils, scented kneaded erasers

\$1 – dual pencil sharpener/eraser, color changing pens, glow in the dark kneaded erasers, pop-it bracelets

\$1.25 – mash-up scented erasers, 6 color pens, maze pens, adorkable mechanical pencils, putty

\$1.50 – Spy pens, pop-it fidget spinners, earbuds, 3 pack notepads \$1.75 - paint brush pens
