Parents and teachers may refer students for testing within the following timelines.

OCTOBER 1ST DEADLINE FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 1 - 12

DECEMBER 1ST DEADLINE FOR STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN KINDERGARTEN & 2ND GRADERS ALL of kindergarten will be screened in the Fall, however if you would like to refer them you may do so before December 1st.

ALL 2nd graders will participate in a grade level administration of a cognitive abilities test during the fall semester so there is no need to refer them for testing.

#### HOW TO MAKE A REFERRAL

If you are interested in having your child tested this year, please email the Advanced Academics Specialist, Jean Neyland, at jneyland@ccisd.net . Please include your child's: Full Name, Homeroom Teacher, & Grade. Your child will not be able to be tested until all forms are returned.
